Blackjack White Earthenware Clay is a low kiln-fired clay formulated from a blend of several natural clays and minerals that produce a talc-white body. It has a silky-smooth texture with good plasticity.

- Blackjack White Earthenware Clay is gray when wet, but fires to a white color.
- This earthenware clay is good for beginners and professionals.
- Blackjack White Earthenware Clay fires in a kiln from cone 04-06. If you are using a digital kiln, consult your instructions or online resources for proper cone to temperature conversion.
- Glazes can be applied directly to the greenware for a single firing.
- Glazes can also be applied to bisqueware and then glaze fired.
- For glaze firing, leave the bottom of the piece unglazed so it does not stick to the kiln shelf. If you wish to glaze the bottom of your piece, set it on stilts to keep it off the shelf surface.
- Earthenware clay pieces are not waterproof after firing.
