THE BASICS

Materials: any of these air dry clays:

Plus Clay

La Doll






clay blade
knife
cookie cutters (optional)
flat surface to dry tiles

clay roller kit



Step 1:


after cutting off a portion of clay



roll out the clay using the 3/16 inch bar included with the clay kit.

Step 2:


cut strips using a knife



make the strips in different widths


Step 3:

cut the tiles




use a knife or clay blade to cut the strips into tiles


to make larger tiles use a square cutter




Step 4:




use a knife to draw stripes, diamonds or whatever you like one way to make a variety of tiles is to make your own designs






if the tile is big enough after making a design cut the tile into two pieces




Step 5:

Another way to make designs is to use a stamp



a few things to remember when using a stamp:

- use a simple stamp without too many details
- stamp several times and then use a blade to cut individual tiles
